

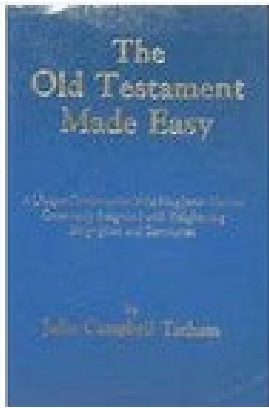
Studying the Bible Lesson more deeply: suggestions

<p>Resolve things into thoughts: go from the literal and historical to the metaphysical and inspirational</p>	<p>“1. As adherents of Truth, we take the inspired Word of the Bible as our sufficient guide to eternal Life.” (SH 497:3)</p> <p>“The Scriptures are very sacred. 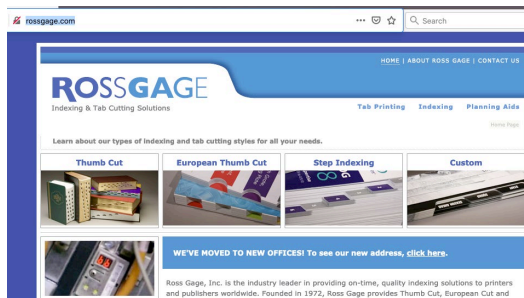
