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Foundational purpose of bringing Christ's healing to our community and world

Jesus established his church and maintained his mission on a spiritual foundation of Christ-healing.

Webster's 1828 Dictionary FOUNDA'TION, noun

- **1.** The basis of an edifice; usually a wall of stone which supports the edifice.
- 2. The act of fixing the basis.
- **3.** The basis or ground work, or any thing; that on which any thing stands, and by which it is supported. Christ is the *foundation* of the church.
- **5.** Endowment; a donation or legacy appropriated to support an institution, and constituting a permanent fund, usually for a charitable purpose.

S&H 138:6–26 [Bold added]

It was now evident to Peter that divine Life, Truth, and Love, and not a human personality, was the healer of the sick and a rock, a firm foundation in the realm of harmony. On this spiritually scientific basis Jesus explained his cures, which appeared miraculous to outsiders. He showed that diseases were cast out neither by corporeality, by materia medica, nor by hygiene, but by the divine Spirit, casting out the errors of mortal mind. The supremacy of Spirit was the foundation on which Jesus built. His sublime summary points to the religion of Love.

Jesus established in the Christian era the precedent for all Christianity, theology, and healing. Christians are under as direct orders now, as they were then, to be Christlike, to possess the Christ-spirit, to follow the Christ-example, and to heal the sick as well as the sinning. It is easier for Christianity to cast out sickness than sin, for the sick are more willing to part with pain than are sinners to

give up the sinful, so-called pleasure of the senses. The Christian can prove this to-day as readily as it was proved centuries ago.

Luke 6:47, 48 [Bold added]

47 Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like:

48 He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.

Mis 140:28 [Bold added]

Built on the rock, our church will stand the storms of ages: though the material superstructure should crumble into dust, the fittest would survive, — the spiritual idea would live, a perpetual type of the divine Principle it reflects.

Revelation 21:1, 2, 14, 19, 20 [Bold added]

- 1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.
- 2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- 14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
- 19 And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;
- 20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolyte; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

See Exodus 28:17-20 for these precious stones in the breastplate of the High Priest.

Precious Stones Meanings according to Funk and Wagnall:

Jasper light-illumination

Sapphire sincerity, constancy, truth
Chalcedony gratitude for Christ truth
Emerald immortal, incorruptible
Sardonyx harmony of bride and groom

Sardius courage, wisdom
Chrysolite truth appearing
Beryl joy, agelessness
Topaz love, spirituality
Chrysoparasus eternal life

Jacinth might

Amethyst love, spiritual power
