

I have been thinking deeply about a verse from Hymn 273. It reads in part, "Partners of a glorious hope, Lift your hearts and voices up..." (Christian Science Hymnal, No. 273). These words have prompted me to consider prayerfully: What inspires our Christian Science nurses and staff, Board members, volunteers, and many others to give so generously of their time, prayers, and financial supportand with such unselfed love for Peace Haven, individually and collectively? The answer is, of course, healing.

Healings in ourselves and others act as waymarks to a higher understanding of God. Peace Haven Withdraws from Medicare

AN ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE PEACE HAVEN BOARD OF TRUSTEES

It is with great love for our community, patients, and staff that Peace Haven discontinued participation in the federal Medicare program as of April 1, 2022. This move came as a prayerful, gradual unfoldment and desire to uplift the atmosphere needed to keep Peace Haven a pure beacon of light for healing.

The decision to withdraw from Medicare does not, in any way, change the availability of Christian Science nursing for any individual who comes to Peace Haven for care. Financial assistance continues to be available, as needed, through Peace Haven's Benevolence Fund and the National Fund for Christian Science Nursing (NFCSN).

Administered by The Principle Foundation, the NFCSN provides financial assistance for costs associated with Christian Science nursing, such as private duty Christian Science nursing care, Visiting Christian Science nursing care, as well as care in Christian Science nursing facilities. We are deeply grateful for the availability and generosity of this charitable organization. More information about NFCSN can be found at https://nfcsn.org. This move away from Medicare frees Peace Haven and its patients from any encumbrances from outside directives and federal guidelines, reporting requirements, describing symptoms, and the like. It more fully allows Peace Haven to maintain the purest sense of spiritual unfoldment and uplift.

As we seek to provide a refuge for those seeking spiritual refreshment, spiritual healing, and practical Christian Science nursing care, this separation from government oversight removes medical thought and intrusion for patients and staff, and ensures the pure spiritual atmosphere at Peace Haven that is so needed for our mission to support Christian Science healing. As we sing in a cherished hymn, "The Healer by Gennesaret/Shall walk the rounds with thee" (Christian Science Hymnal, No. 96).

We joyfully share this news with confidence that this decision will infinitely bless all who come to Peace Haven. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:" (Eph 1:3).

We also extend our heartfelt gratitude to our generous supporters. The love the Christian Science field has shown to Peace Haven throughout its nearly 70 years of serving Christian Scientists continues to be a blessing. It is a privilege to continue this work of Christian service.

Then, while making the beds, I began to think of the spiritual qualities that our patients expressed and that I expressed. Finally, I made them with the love and care I would take if the Christ himself were to lay his weary head on them after a long day of holding unswerving thought over the world for God.

One morning while making a bed, the person occupying the room and I began an uplifting conversation that led to my sharing my method of making beds. That person's comment was "that's the reason last night was my first night I felt such complete rest."

How grateful I am that God took such a mundane process and lifted it to such a lofty place.

Support the Permanence of Christian Science Nursing

Christian Science nursing is demonstrated daily in your heart and outward expressions of good, and in the hearts and activities of Peace Haven's staff. Our individual and collective demonstrations of nursing qualities are a blessing to our world and a wonderful expression of Church (*Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures*, p. 583).

Christian Science nursing is part of Church. It became so when Mary Baker Eddy added the last By-Law to the *Manual of The Mother Church*, "Christian Science Nurse" (Art. 8, Sect. 31). Thus, it is part of the Church Mrs. Eddy declared was designed "...to be built on the Rock, Christ; even the understanding and demonstration of divine Truth, Life, and Love, healing and saving the world from sin and death; thus to reflect in some degree the Church Universal and Triumphant," (*Church Manual*, p. 19).

As long as there is a need for church, there is a need for Christian Science nursing. For this reason, Peace Haven's newly established Board-Designated Sustainability Endowment provides an opportunity for the Christian Science field to help ensure that Christian Science nursing, just like church, is available for generations to come.

Unlike Peace Haven's Operating Fund, which covers day-to-day expenses, the Board-Designated Sustainability Endowment is invested so it can grow in value over time. The intent is for Peace Haven to access the interest the fund generates to offset future major expenses—over and above what the existing Operating Fund typically supports. Such future costs might include significant building and grounds repairs; helping with replacement, additions, or needed restructuring; maintaining competitive salaries, retirement plans, and other benefits for Peace Haven's dedicated staff; sustaining Christian Science nurses' training opportunities (e.g., student tuition, room and board, travel expenses); and more. All of this will help ensure the permanence of Christian Science nursing for years to come.

It is essential to our worldwide Church that Christian Science nursing remains available to all who seek it. Peace Haven's Board-Designated Sustainability Endowment will help ensure that those who choose to rely on Christian Science for healing will have access to the watchful and tender care of students of Christian Science who are skillfully and prayerfully ready and who want to help them.

We are grateful that Peace Haven's services support the healing efficacy of Christian Science. What a blessing to ponder this as we read our Leader's comments on page 154 and 155 of *The First Church of Christ, Scientist, and Miscellany*, "Communing heart with heart, mind with mind, soul with soul, wherein and whereby we are looking heavenward, is not looking nor gravitating earthward, take it in whatever sense you may. Such communing uplifts man's being; it makes healing the sick and reforming the sinner a mutual aid society, which is effective here and now."
