In our study of the Holy City we have come to see God's great promise to Abraham of a place prepared for him, and all that do the works of Abraham, as a very relevant promise for all of us today. God's promise transcends the physical promised-land to the ever-present spiritual promised-land — the kingdom of heaven within. This kingdom or Holy City or new heaven and new earth is true existence, spiritual reality, present here and now. Man's indestructible relationship with God is the only reality of his being. Through listening to and obeying God as Abraham did we are blessed with the vision of spiritual reality.

Ps. 29:11 [bold added] 11 The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

S&H 535:29 [bold added]

In the first chapter of Genesis we read: "And God 30 called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together

God is the creator of man, and, the divine Principle of man remaining perfect, the divine idea or reflection, man, remains perfect. Man is the expression Indestructible relationship

The relations of God and man, divine Principle and idea, are indestructible in Science; and Science knows no lapse from nor return to harmony, but holds the divine

3 order or spiritual law, in which God and all that He creates are perfect and eternal, to have remained unchanged in its eternal history.

In Revelation xxi. 1 we read: —

And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first 21 heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

Accompanying this scientific consciousness was another revelation, even the declaration from heaven, su-

- 15 **preme harmony, that God, the divine Principle** Nearness **of harmony, is ever with men, and they are** of Deity **His people.** Thus man was no longer regarded as a mis-
- 18 erable sinner, but as **the blessed child of God.** Why? Because St. John's corporeal sense of the heavens and earth had vanished, **and in place of this false sense was**
- 21 the spiritual sense, the subjective state by which he could see the new heaven and new earth, which involve the spiritual idea and consciousness of reality.

S&H 574:5-16

He writes, in Revelation xxi. 9: —

- And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will show thee the bride,
- 9 the Lamb's wife.

This ministry of Truth, this message from divine Love, carried John away in spirit. It exalted him till he be-

- 12 came conscious of the spiritual facts of being and the "New Jerusalem, coming down from God, out of heaven," the spiritual outpour-consolation
- 15 ing of bliss and glory, which he describes as the city which "lieth foursquare."

S&H 575:7–13 (to 2nd .) [bold added]

This sacred city, described in the Apocalypse (xxi. 16) as one that "lieth foursquare" and cometh "down from

- 9 God, out of heaven," **represents the light and** The city **glory of divine Science.** The builder and foursquare maker of this New Jerusalem is God, as we read in the
- 12 book of Hebrews; and it is "a city which hath foundations." The description is metaphoric.

S&H 576:8–23 [bold added]

In Revelation xxi. 22, further describing this holy city,

9 the beloved Disciple writes: —

And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

- 12 There was no temple, that is, no material structure in which to worship God, for He must be worshipped in spirit and in love. The word *temple* also The shrine
- 15 means *body*. The Revelator was familiar celestial with Jesus' use of this word, as when Jesus spoke of his material body as the temple to be temporarily rebuilt
- 18 (John ii. 21). What further indication need we of the real man's incorporeality than this, that John saw heaven and earth with "no temple [body] therein"?
- 21 This kingdom of God "is within you," is within

reach of man's consciousness here, and the spiritual idea reveals it.

S&H 577:12–31 [bold added]

- 12 This spiritual, holy habitation has no boundary nor limit, but its four cardinal points are: first, the Word of Life, Truth, and Love; second, The city of
- 15 the Christ, the spiritual idea of God; third, **our God** Christianity, which is the outcome of the divine Principle of the Christ-idea in Christian history; fourth,
- 18 Christian Science, which to-day and forever interprets this great example and the great Exemplar. This city of our God has no need of sun or satellite, for Love
- 21 is the light of it, and divine Mind is its own interpreter. All who are saved must walk in this light. Mighty potentates and dynasties will lay down their honors
- 24 within the heavenly city. Its gates open towards light and glory both within and without, for all is good, and nothing can enter that city, which "defileth, . . . or
- 27 maketh a lie."

25 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. 26 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, **sent him to bless you**, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

- 3 earth, inhabited by beings under the control of supreme wisdom?

Let us rid ourselves of the belief that man is separated 6 from God, and obey only the divine Principle, Life and Love. Here is the great point of departure for all true spiritual growth.

1 God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause his face to shine upon us; Selah. 2 That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations. 3 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee.
